#### Ideally what do we require?

Well a café that meets the needs of all those who use our theatre and additionally brings more people to The Questors. In talking to our friends, patrons and members, a café that offers:

- all day snacks and refreshments
- lunch
- an interval service on performance nights

### With a potential to offer:

- breakfast
- a pre-rehearsal menu and refreshments
- a pre-theatre menu and refreshments
- catering services for meetings and events

The usable space is approximately 7m (w) x10m (l) with seating for approximately 30 covers.

We need you to be aware that we operate a venue that during certain evenings and weekend times needs its upper foyer to be a rehearsal or educational space – around 30 instances a year – and those dates would be made clear to you.

In addition members expect to be able to sit at tables in the café if they are working on shows or waiting to audition but they will most definitely move if space is required by café patrons.

#### Tell me more about The Questors Theatre


